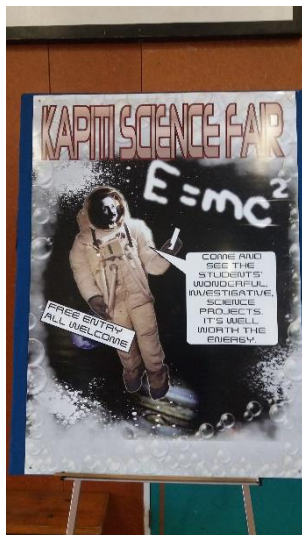

Dear Parents of Kapiti Primary School students,

We are very excited to be able to host a state-of-the-art virtual reality experience for Kapiti Primary School. This is an opportunity for your children to experience this amazing technology and get an insight to the future.

When: Sunday afternoon on 17th June from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm.

Where: Kapiti Primary School Hall.

Format: 15 minute time slots booked in advance. Please arrive at least 5 minutes before your booked session so that we can ensure that your child has the full benefit of their time.

Cost: \$10 per session. If you have more than one child, then additional children are \$5. This is used to pay for the cost of the equipment.

Bookings: Please book a time slot and make payment at the office. Please note that we cannot take a booking without your payment. There are only a limited number of places so bookings will be made on a first-come-first-serve basis. Please make your booking as soon as possible.

Restrictions: This experience is open to children in Year 4 and above. This is restricted because the experience may be overwhelming for younger children and the equipment is fragile.

What is Virtual Reality?

Virtual reality is a virtual world where you can experience flying around the world or travelling across the galaxy, swimming in the ocean with whales or building a house. The experiences are limited by only your imagination!

Who is running the lab? The lab will be hosted by Kapiti Primary students (Luke and Logan Soar) and supervised by parents.
