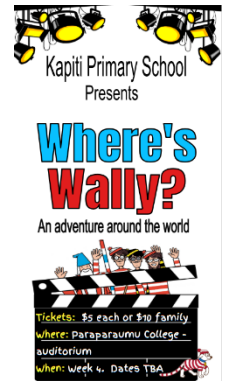
## Kia ora friends and whanau.
