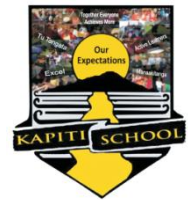

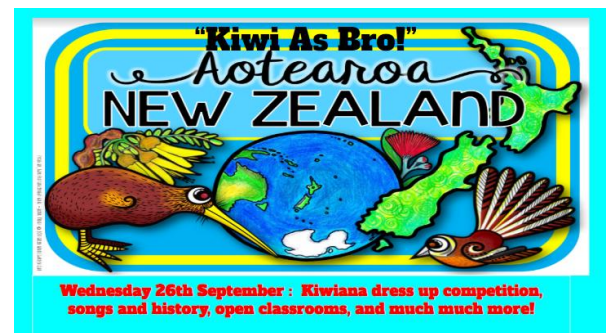


Art Splash
