## **Movie Night Success:**

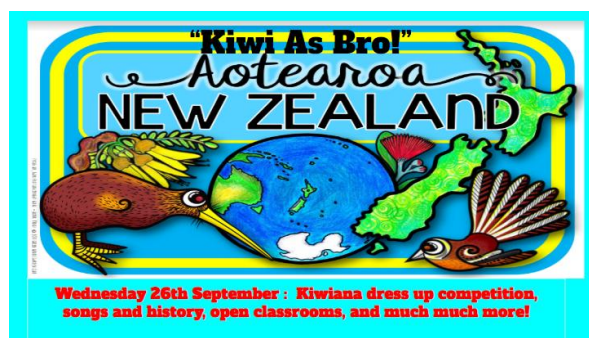
