On Friday 26 May, 10s of thousands of students gathered around New Zealand to protest for climate change. In Wellington alone, 100s gathered.

The Raumati Technology Center teachers took a small group of interested kids to join the strike for climate change. Three students from Kapiti Primary School trained down to Wellington to take part in the protest.

The protesters started at Willis Street, then headed down to parliament. They walked slowly, chanting and holding homemade signs. We were protesting for the environment, stopping carbon emissions and to lower the voting age to 16.

When we got to parliament some of the protesters got up to speak. They laid out what they wanted to change and accused the government of not taking action.

After the speeches, the protesters started to head off. We headed to the train to journey back to Kapiti.

Overall it was a very interesting day and we are glad we took part in something so meaningful.

### Important Changes to Open Days and Open Evening at Kāpiti College 21st June

As you will know, there has been huge disruption for our students this year due to industrial action. The only way to run the normal Open Evening on the 21st would be for all students to be at home for the day, which we are not prepared to do. We have therefore decided to restructure the opportunities for parents to see the school.

Year 8s will come along to the Open Day guided tours as arranged. Parents have two options:

1. You can join the guided tours of the school at the same time as the Year 8s. This can be either the morning tour, starting at 9.30am, or the afternoon tour starting at 12.30pm. It does not matter whether your Year 8 is coming at that time. The tours run for two hours and begin in Coastlands Theatre, Te Raukura ki Kāpiti Performing Arts' Centre.


