National Young Leaders Day

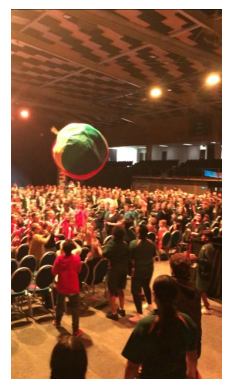
Our student council had a wonderful time at the National Young Leaders Day last week. We value building student leaders at school and it was great to reward them with this day of inspiring speakers.
